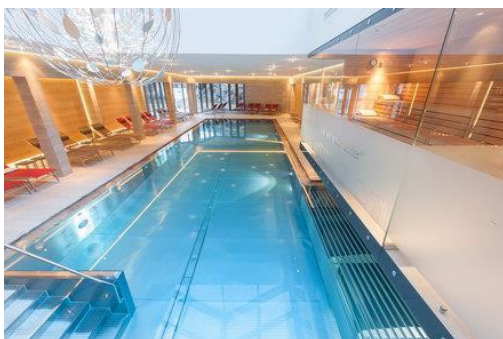

Ötztal, Austria (in Tirol) is definitely one of the hot spots of the Alps with 3 peaks over 3,000 Meters (10,000 FT) and the most vertical in Austria at 1990m. Sölden is the place for World Cup skiing and snowboarding in Tirol and provides guests with a huge range of winter sports – the US Ski Team has chosen Sölden as their official European training base. The latest James Bond movie Spectre was filmed there. Over the years Sölden has become famous for its great apres-ski scene.

SKIING

The Sölden-Hochsölden-Gaislachkogel sector of the Ötztal Arena Ski Area 140km (80+ miles) of trails connected by a number of high capacity lifts and long runs, the greatest of which descends for 10km (6 miles) over a 1675m (5,500 feet) vertical. This however is now even bigger thanks to the lift link to the glaciers meaning that the 30 plus lifts, many of them state-of-the-art gondolas and chairs, links up to around 150km (90 miles) runs. At the peak of each of Sölden's Big-3 slopes, there are breathtaking panoramic views can be had from each of the 3 different viewing platforms: included.

HOTEL

Located in the center of Sölden, only 100 yards from the NEWLY UPGRADED Giggijoch cable car. The traditionally furnished rooms all feature cable TV, a safe, and a bathroom with hairdryer. In the Tyrolerhof, traditional and the modern combine to create a wonderful atmosphere. The hotel is an oasis of well-being and wellness. Enjoy great food with their Tyrolean cuisine and international dishes or après ski around the crackling fire.

Brussels - After a full week of skiing, head to the Belgium capital city of Brussels. Most newcomers to Brussels arrive with a firm image in their minds that the city is the center of international politics and hosts many international organizations. The city is so much more as it is considered the most diverse areas in all of Europe filled with architectural wonders to explore. A taste for fine chocolates will not go un-rewarded as there are walking tours of the various chocolate stores. A short distance away are the UNESCO recognized medieval cities of Ghent and Burges. There you can take in the period architecture or ride a boat on one of the many canals or wonder down the cobblestone streets of the romantic Minnewater (Lake of Love). The accommodations are at the four star Hotel Metropole. Extension participants will go directly to Brussels from Solden and will not stay in Luzern.

Space Availability

All spots on this trip will be filled on a **first come - first served basis**, and are secured ONLY with payment of the initial deposit of \$1,000 per person. Trip participants must also become a paid member of the club for the 2017/2018 season once **member enrollment opens on 7/1/2017**. In the past these trips have sold out very quickly, so don't delay.
