We will ski 2 days at Lake Louise upon arrival (Sunday/Monday). At the end of the ski day on Monday, we will board a bus to head to Revelstoke where you can ski 3 or 4 days

**Skiing:**

Located in the heart of the magnificent Canadian Rockies, **Lake Louise** has a legendary 4,200 skiable acres of world-class terrain. Their unique layout with beginner, intermediate and expert runs from every chair allows your family or group of varying abilities to ski and share the experience together. They've got endless chutes, glades and gullies, gentle slopes, cruising runs, remote bowls and some of the most challenging terrain in the Rockies.

**Revelstoke Mountain Resort** boasts North America's greatest vertical at 1,713 metres (5,620 ft) along with an average snowfall of 10.5 metres (34.4 ft). The resort also offers 3,121 acres of fall line skiing, high alpine bowls, renowned gladed terrain and endless groomers.

**Accommodations:**

Surrounded by soaring mountain peaks, the majestic Victoria Glacier and a glistening emerald lake, the **iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise hotel is located in Alberta's Banff National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. - Second and final payment depending on your lift ticket choice is due December 1, 2019 (see breakout below)

**Trip insurance is highly recommended at sign-up for cancellation. If you need to cancel, you must provide written notice to the trip leaders.** Charges will apply (per person) based upon the date of receipt of written cancellation notice:

Please Note that every effort will be made to substitute from the **waiting list** (if there is one) for anyone who must cancel. Any questions about the cancellation policy should be directed to your trip leaders. Changes in the itinerary will result in a \$100 change fee, plus any additional charges from the airline or travel agent as a result of the change. That is if the change is possible.

### For tourist visits to Canada of less than 180 days,

U.S. citizens do not need visas. Other types of travel (e.g., to work, study, or immigrate) generally requires visas. For complete information on visa categories and requirements, consult the [Citizenship and Immigration Canada \(CIC\) website](#).

Anyone with a criminal record (including misdemeanors or alcohol-related driving offenses) may not be able to enter Canada without first obtaining an "[approval for rehabilitation](#)" well in advance of any planned travel. To determine whether you may be inadmissible and how to overcome this finding, please refer to the [CIC website](#). Entry into Canada is solely determined by Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) officials in accordance with Canadian law. Please see [the CBSA's website](#) for full details.

Travel Programs: Both the U.S. and Canadian governments urge frequent travelers to join the [NEXUS trusted traveler program](#).

Entry into Canada: Canadian law requires that all persons entering Canada carry both proof of citizenship and proof of identity. A valid U.S. passport, passport card, or NEXUS card satisfies these requirements for U.S. citizens.

Children under 16 need only present proof of U.S. citizenship.

Entry into the United States: When traveling by air from Canada, U.S. citizens are required by U.S. law to present a U.S. passport book. A few exceptions to this rule exist and a full list of documents that can be used at land and sea borders are provided on the [U.S. Customs and Border Protection \(CBP\) website](#).
