# Day Bus Trips

## General Info, Bus Pickup Locations, Cancellation / Refund Policies

### Seat(s) On Sale:

- **Each day bus trip will open for sale 45 days prior to the departure date of the trip.**
- Seats on the day bus trip(s) can only be purchased through the <http://aeskiclub.com> website after logging in with your membership information.

### Bus Pick Up Locations:

- Day bus trips pick up club members from **TWO** locations:
  - Exit 21 off I-91 (Middletown): "Park and Ride" Commuter Lot on Industrial Park Road off Rte 372.  
**\*\* NOTE: This is NOT the commuter lot right off the highway exit ramp on Rte 372. \*\***
  - Exit 38 off I-91 (Windsor): "Park and Ride" Commuter Lot on Poquonock Ave (Rte. 75)
- The bus DEPARTS from the pick-up locations at a specific time for each trip as designated on the day bus trip confirmation (approximately 5:30-6:00am from Exit 21 & 6:00-6:30am from Exit 38).
- The bus departs from the ski resort between 4:00 pm - 4:30 pm (typically).

### General Information:

- All trip participants **MUST BE AE SKI CLUB MEMBERS**. We do not allow guests on our day bus trips.
- Our day bus trips are family friendly, club members of all ages are welcome.
- Anyone who is under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (who is also a member of the AE Ski Club) on any day bus trip. If needed, a parent or guardian (who is also a member of the AE Ski Club) who does not ski can take the bus for the "bus only" price.
- The club provides a morning snack on the bus ride to the ski resort (typically bagels -n- cream cheese or muffins or donuts).
- Movies are shown on the trip for your viewing pleasure!
- The bus DOES NOT stop for food on the ride home.

### Cancellation Policy:

- Please contact the trip leader as soon as you know you (or someone in your group) will be canceling from the trip, even on the morning of the trip.
- If the cancellation is made 7 days (168 hours) or more from departure date/time, you will receive a full refund of what you paid for the seat(s) that you are canceling.
- If the **cancellation is made less than 7 days (168 hours) from departure** date/time you will receive **NO REFUND**.
- Not showing up for the bus on the day of the trip is considered a cancellation. See policy above for a cancellation made less than 7 days from departure date/time.

### Refund Policy:

Refunds for day bus trips will typically not be processed until after the day of the trip. Please allow up to 3 to 4 weeks from date of the trip for refunds to be processed by the trip leader and club board of directors.

### Required Documentation:

Some of our bus trips are run in conjunction with CT Ski Council Awareness / Discount ticket days, therefore you should be sure to **bring the AE Ski Club Membership card(s) for yourself and all the members in your group**. You may also need one other form of ID (typically a driver's license).



# Day Bus Trips Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Can someone who is under 18 participate in a day bus trip without a parent/guardian attending also?**

A: No, anyone who is under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (who is also a member of the AE Ski Club) on any day bus trip. If needed, a parent or guardian (who is also a member of the AE Ski Club) who does not ski can take the bus for the "bus only" price.

**Q: Can I drive myself to the mountain on the day of the bus trip to get the same discount lift ticket rate as those on the day bus trip?**

A: It depends upon the day bus trip, because many (but not all) of our day bus trips are run in conjunction with CT Ski Council days.

In such cases where the trip is on the same day/location as a CT Ski Council Awareness Day, you can drive yourself to the mountain and purchase a lift ticket (1 per member card) at the discounted price listed on the following flier. The location at each mountain to purchase these discounted lift tickets is also listed on the CSC website Awareness Days page: <http://skiclub.com/ct-ski-council-welcome/awareness-days/>

However, if the trip is NOT on the same day/location as a CT Ski Council Awareness Day, you will NOT be able to purchase a discounted ticket without being on the day bus trip.

**Q: Can non AE Ski Club members go on the day bus trips?**

**Q: I'm a member of another CT Ski Council club. Can I participate in your AE Ski Club bus trips?**

A: The answer to both questions is No. Anyone participating in an AE Ski Club trip MUST BE a member of our club. Our club trips are subsidized by the membership fees paid by our members, therefore anyone participating in the trip must be a member of the club.

**Q: Can an AE Ski Club member meet the bus at the mountain on the day of the day bus trip to get a discounted lift ticket?**

A: No, this is against club policy.

**Q: I signed up for a trip (or trips) and have my PayPal receipt but I haven't received a confirmation email for one or more of the trips. How can I confirm my trip reservation?**

A: Please contact the primary trip leader for the trip(s) in question. Each primary trip leader is responsible for sending out confirmation email for their trip to the trip's participants. The primary trip leader contacts for each trip can be found on our "bus trips" page on our website.

**Q: The day bus trip that I would like to go on is currently SOLD OUT, is there a waiting list I can get on?**

A: We advise contacting the primary trip leader to get on the waiting list (if one is being kept) for any trip that is currently sold out. The primary trip leader contacts for each trip can be found on the "bus trips" page on our website.

**Q: What is your policy for cancellations or refunds on day bus trips?**
