Space Availability

All spots on this trip will be filled on a **first come – first served basis** and are secured ONLY with payment of the initial deposit of \$250 per person. **All trip participants must be paid members of the club for the 2023/2024 season prior to sign up and must purchase a membership for the 2024/2025 season.** In the past these trips have sold out very quickly, so do not delay. A waiting list will be formed, if necessary.

Payment Policy

You must be signed up for membership for **2023/2024 and or 2024/2025** before signing up for the trip (enroll/reenroll online at https://www.aeskiclub.com/). The initial non-refundable deposit is payable only on the website via PayPal, Venmo or credit card. You can make the second and final payments by check or money order payable to the "AE Ski Club". We do not accept credit cards for payments other than the initial deposit. Checks returned as unpaid by the bank will be assessed a \$35.00 fee per occurrence. Cancellation Policy

In the event of a trip cancellation, every attempt will be made to provide refunds OR defer the trip to a later date. Trip cancellations may occur because of COVID-related restrictions or other issues. Each trip will be handled on a per trip basis, not an individual participant basis. See the full cancellation policy outlined in this flyer, including the individual participant cancellation policy. We strongly recommend each participant purchase trip insurance that allows for Cancellation For Any Reason (CFAR) to best protect themselves.

If you need to cancel, you must provide written notice to the trip leaders. Charges will apply (per person) based upon the date of receipt of written cancellation notice as indicated below:

Every effort will be made to substitute from the waiting list (if there is one) for anyone who must cancel. Any questions about the cancellation policy should be directed to your trip leaders. Changes to the itinerary may result in a \$100-\$450 change fee, plus any additional charges as a result of the change, if the change is possible.

Trip Cancellation/Interruption Insurance:

We strongly recommend the purchase of trip insurance covering, accident, sickness or death of a participant or covered family member that would result in cancellation either prior to or during the trip. AE Ski Club agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Group from all costs, claims, liabilities, fees, attorney fees, and obligations related to harm caused by AE Ski Club's negligence or intentional misconduct. Group agrees to be expressly and solely responsible for any damage or injury caused or suffered by any Group member, or any person associated, affiliated, or related to any Group member.
- C. Waiver. I agree that neither AE Ski Club nor its affiliates, nor its or their volunteers, employees or agents, shall be liable for any damage, loss (including personal injury, death and property loss), inconvenience or expense occasioned by any act or omission of any supplier providing services, or of any other person, or by any change in itinerary, unless caused by the negligence of AE Ski Club or its affiliates or their employees or agents in the contractual duty. No person other than a representative of AE Ski Club authorized by a document in writing is permitted to vary, add or waive any term or condition in this Agreement, including any term or condition set forth in the preceding provisions.
- D. **Acknowledgment of Risk.** I understand and agree that travel involves the risk of delays, inconveniences, cancellations, thefts, terrorism, crimes, and mechanical problems, as well as the risk of injuries. I accept responsibility for these risks for myself and my family.
