Athens is one of the world's oldest cities, with its recorded history spanning over 3,400 years, and its earliest human presence beginning somewhere between the 11th and 7th millennia BC. The city is still dominated by 5th-century BC landmarks, including the Acropolis, a hilltop citadel topped with ancient buildings like the colonnaded Parthenon temple.

Space Availability

All spots on this trip will be filled on a First Come – First Served Basis.

- Existing Active Members 2023/2024 You can sign up for the trip first, but you must become a paid active member of the club for the 2024/2025 season once membership enrollment opens up in July.
- New Members You must become a paid active member of the club for the 2023/2024 season before you sign up for this trip. Membership for 2024/2025 season will automatically be renewed in July at no cost.

Payment Policy

You must be signed up for membership for 2024/2025 before signing up for the trip (enroll/re-enroll online at https://www.aeskiclub.com/). The initial non-refundable deposit is payable only on the website via PayPal, Venmo or credit card. You can make the second and final payments by check or money order payable to the "AE Ski Club". We do not accept credit cards for payments other than the initial deposit. Checks returned as unpaid by the bank will be assessed a \$30.00 fee per occurrence. Cancellation Policy

In the event of a trip cancellation, every attempt will be made to provide refunds OR defer the trip to a later date. Trip cancellations may occur because of COVID-related restrictions or other issues. Each trip will be handled on a per trip basis, not an individual participant basis. If you need to cancel, you must provide written notice to the trip leaders. Charges will apply (per person) based upon the date of receipt of written cancellation notice as indicated below:
